# SENIOR Fall Trip

On Monday, **October 23**, **at 11am**, we will head out for <u>the Edinburg Mill</u>, a Shenandoah Valley Cultural Heritage Museum and Virginia Historic Landmark. The 1848 Edinburg Mill recreates Shenandoah Valley hands-on history with memorabilia, antiques, old equipment and tools, as well as exhibits about Civil War history, the nation's first civilian conservation camp, plus more. Learn the fascinating story of how the mill survived Sheridan's fires during the Civil War and keep an eye out for the resident ghost Frankie! The mill also houses Heritage Mill Wines 1848, the Edinburg Mill Restaurant, and The Museum Gift Shop.
